If you've driven by our new building site, you know that a lot has happened in the month since the All-Congregation Tour on June 29. More walls are up, most notably those in the sanctuary and backstage. The stage and steps are walkable now. Trusses are up in the entry hall and RE. Plumbing is going in, so you can actually see where the kitchen equipment is planned. By the time you read this, more trusses will be in and the building will continue to take shape.

The site walls are growing. Masons have begun facing them with the same tuff that is native to our site (visible from the road cut on Perlette as well the boulders near the roads). Great care is being taken with the design to emulate a volcanic upheaval, while complementing the building design.

Final details are being worked out with AV and IT. There are still many decisions to be made: exterior and interior signage, play area fencing and play area final design, donor wall design, and general outfitting of the building so it is ready to operate when the building is ready for us to move in.

You're welcome to drive by often to see the changes as they occur. If you're a cyclist or walker, the dirt path paralleling NW Skyliners will also give you a nice view.
